

**LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING
CITY OF WISCONSIN DELLS
MARCH 21, 2016**

Ald. Freel called the meeting to order at 6:00P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

1. Present: Ald. Freel, Mayor Brian Landers and Ald. Ed Fox
Excused: Ald. Ed Wojnicz
Others: City Clerk/Coordinator Nancy Holzem, Police Chief Jody Ward, City Planner/Zoning Administrator Chris Tollaksen, Public Works/Utilities Director David Holzem, Ald. Brian Holzem, Ald. Dar Mor, Assistant City Attorney Joe Hasler, Kelli Trumble, Allan Hanson, and Ed Legge from the *Dells Events*.
2. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to approve the February 8, 2016 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the application for renewal for Taxicab Service Licenses for the licensing period of April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017 submitted by the following:
 - Calin Bobeanu for City Taxi
 - Larry K. Volkey for Dells Cab
 - Jeremy Ringdahl for Kangaroo Taxi
 - Michael Coleman for Sureway Taxi Service
 - Keshia Gregerson for Wisconsin Dells Taxi

Approval was contingent upon vehicles passing inspection. Motion carried unanimously.

4. The committee reviewed a proposed ordinance to update code sec. 8.04 – Waterways Regulations. The proposed changes were requested by WP&L (Alliant) in order to install and maintain a buoy system. The DNR has requested written consent as well as an approved ordinance from the city in order for them to do this. Motion was made by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend the ordinance to the Common Council for approval. Motion carried unanimously.
5. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend to the Common Council for approval, a proposed ordinance to allow Public Sidewalk Cafes by right in the C-2 Commercial Downtown Zoning District; as well as updates the definition and standards. This will eliminate the need for a Conditional Use Permit. Motion carried unanimously.
6. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend to the Common Council for approval, a proposed ordinance updating the Busker Permit process. The changes will allow the WDVCB to be part of the permitting process; and also addresses noise and disturbances. Motion carried unanimously.
7. Next meeting was scheduled for Monday, April 11, 2016 at 6:00pm. Agenda items will include renewal of Firework Sales and Riding Stable Licenses. Chairperson Freel suggested

and ordinance to prohibit rental properties from allowing dogs. It was suggested that he meet with the police chief to address his concerns as the city currently has ordinances to deal with nuisance dogs as well as vicious dogs whether they are at rental properties or not.

8. Motion by Ald. Fox seconded by Mayor Lander to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:20pm.
