

**LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING  
CITY OF WISCONSIN DELLS  
SEPTEMBER 14, 2015**

Ald. Freel called the meeting to order at 7:00P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

1. Present: Ald. Freel, Mayor Brian Landers, Ald. Ed Wojnicz and Ald. Ed Fox  
  
Others: City Clerk Nancy R. Holzem, City Treasurer Karen Terry, Public Works & Utilities Director David Holzem, City Planner/Zoning Administrator Chris Tollaksen, Police Chief Jody Ward, Ald. Brian Holzem, City Attorney Joe Hasler, and Ed Legge from the *Dells Events*.
2. Motion by Ald. Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Fox to approve the minutes of the July 20, 2015 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
3. The committee reviewed a proposed ordinance to modify the composition of the City Plan Commission so that the City Planner, who prepares that staff report for permits, is not a voting member. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Freel to recommend the proposed ordinance to the Common Council for approval. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Wojnicz to recommend to the Common Council for approval, a proposed ordinance to adopt by reference state law violations as municipal code offenses for: 193.32 - Trespassing on Railroad; 940.32 – Stalking; and 948.45 - Contributing to Truancy. Motion carried unanimously.
5. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend to the Common Council for approval, a proposed ordinance which regulates animals at large and exercise. Motion carried unanimously.
6. The committee reviewed the mayor’s 2015-2016 committee goals. 1) Investigate a residential improvement district for Ward 2. Mayor Landers stated that this option along with grants and other funding should be looked at to remove blight in that area as well as address property owners concerns about the neighborhood. 2) Review and implement all city building and safety codes to ensure compliance with state and federal laws. Attorney Hasler stated that he along with City Planner Chris Tollaksen and Fire Inspector Jerry Wolfram will review proposed code changes and have something within the next 30-60 days.
7. Items for referral to next meeting (no date was set):
  - Revamping of ordinance regarding resisting arrest
  - Updates to Building Codes
  - Unlawful to threaten any law enforcement person or public official
8. Motion by Ald. Fox seconded by Ald. Wojnicz to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
