The contract made and entered into by and between the MUNICIPALITY and CONSULTANT, dated (March 28, 2016) is hereby amended as set forth on the following pages.

The primary reason(s) for this amendment:

- The PROJECT completion date has been extended to complete concrete staining and other contract items during the 2017 construction season, supplementary project oversight will be required due to the contract time extension. Additional project oversight and coordination was also required for geotechnical review of R-11-0034, vignette installations, utility relocations (underground electric, gas main and marina lighting) and additional construction items requested by the City (storm sewer, riprap and pavement replacement). This AMENDMENT provides for a time extension of the completion date for CONSULTANT SERVICES, to June 16, 2017 and additional compensation to complete the additional services.
- For geotechnical subsurface soil investigation for retaining wall R-11-0034, due to the uncertainty of existing subsurface conditions that was inaccessible during the design phase. The services are subcontracted to Nummelin Testing Services, Inc.

We are pleased to submit this proposal for the geotechnical subsurface soil investigation for the retaining wall project. We propose to do the subject underground exploration and engineering report in accordance with the standard rates itemized below:

1. Standard soil auger borings: Perform three (3) mud-rotary soil borings. All borings are proposed to a depth of 30', for a total of 90 feet. Soil samples taken every 2.5' in the top 10' and 5' intervals thereafter. Estimate 3 borings at \$450/each. \$ 1350.00

Mobilization/demob of drill crew, rig, all materials to site and return. Lump sum. \$ 632.00

The bore holes will be backfilled in accordance with DNR requirements at \$4.00 per foot. Estimate 90 feet. \$ 360.00

Additional borings, will be performed at the rates listed above. \$ 00.00

Drilling of bedrock or hard material (>50 blows/ft) with augers is not included in the above drilling costs, and will be performed at an additional rate of \$10/foot. Drilling will be terminated at auger or tri-cone refusal or scheduled boring depth, whichever occurs first. Estimate 9 feet of hard drilling @ \$10/foot. \$ 90.00
2. Utility check - Contact diggers hotline. \$ 75.00

OTHER ITEMS OF CONCERN

16. This proposal assumes normal access to the boring locations with an ATV-mounted drill rig. No additional allowances are made for special site preparation to gain access with drill rigs. Nummelin Testing Services, Inc. will not be responsible for any tire ruts, tire marks, damage to any pavement surface or lawn, caused by the normal, prudent operation of a drill rig. One rig-day is assumed in the above estimate. Additional borings requiring a return to the site, may require an additional mob/demob charge. If a drill rig gets stuck, we will charge for all down time as stand-by time and we will charge the cost of any tow truck or bulldozer needed.
17. It is assumed that landowners will be contacted by others before arrival of the drill crew. The drill crew will attempt to contact owner/occupants before entering property, if requested. Telephone numbers of land owners/occupants would be helpful.
18. Mud-rotary drilling may be substituted for the hollow stem auger method if deemed necessary by Nummelin Testing Services, Inc.
19. Borings will be performed to the specified depth or to auger refusal. An attempt will be made to contact client if subsurface conditions may warrant a change in specified boring depth(s). Item 1 above includes costs for the maximum depth of boring anticipated. If shallower borings are performed, because of auger refusal or other reason, Nummelin Testing Services, Inc. will use their discretion when determining the final billing amount. Nummelin Testing Services, Inc. will contact client if cost of boring is anticipated to exceed this estimate.
20. A Monday-Friday daylight only working schedule will be employed. In the event of adverse weather conditions, Nummelin Testing Services, Inc. will use their discretion in scheduling borings.
21. Payment for this work will be due within thirty days after the submission of our invoice, following completion of the work. A service charge of 1.5% per month


The work as itemized above will be accomplished for a total of \$ **3,949.00**. The subsurface soils report will be completed within two weeks of the completion of the borings.





Hi Chris,

Item 6 Base Aggregate Dense - 1 1/4"

Quantity was a little heavy along Illinois Avenue roadway and path, using less 3/4" base and backfill structure.

Item 7 Colored Concrete Path 5-inch, 10-ft wide

The sidewalk ramps at Illinois/River Rd intersection were included in this item and we went a little further south of the River Road overlook and wider along the Illinois Avenue pathway.

Item 14 HMA Pavement, 4-inch, Type E-1

More HMA pavement was placed along the River Rd parapet, due to deterioration, additional pavement was placed in the Illinois/River Rd intersection to have a better tie-in and replace damaged surface and Illinois Avenue was paved a little wider.

209.0200.S Backfill Controlled Low Strength

The soils under the abutments were better than expected, so less material was excavated. the SE corner of the bridge was the only area that required this item.


210.0100 Backfill Structure

Similarly the soils under the roadway along the Marina side were better than expected, so less material was excavated and replaced with backfill structure.

5.04 SNOW REMOVAL

ITEM 7

(1) Definitions.

(a) Street. The "street" as used in this Section shall include public avenues, alleys and roadways.

(b) Snow and Ice Removal. Snow and ice removal is defined as the act of loading snow and ice onto trucks or other conveyances and removing it from the streets and other locations of the City.

(c) Snow and Ice Plowing. Snow and ice plowing is defined as clearing streets of snow and ice by use of plows, bulldozers or by similar means and delivering such snow and ice to one or both sides of the street.

(2) Removal of Snow and Ice.

(a) Petition for Removal of Snow and Ice From Street. The Department of Public Works shall during the winter season, remove the snow and ice from any street or block thereof in the City when petitioned to do so by the property owners or occupants who represent the owners or occupants, of 50 percent of the adjacent property on such street or block thereof.

(b) Removal Required on Certain Streets. The Common Council may, without petition, by a vote of two-thirds or more of its members, cause the snow and ice to be removed from any street or part thereof. The Department of Public Works is hereby directed to remove snow and ice from the following streets:


- i. Broadway from the Wisconsin River Bridge to the southerly extension of the east line of Lot 11, Block 48, Original Plat, City of Wisconsin Dells;
- ii. River Road north of Broadway to the first ally;
- iii. Oak Street north of Broadway to the first alley;
- iv. Elm Street north of Broadway to the first alley;
- v. Elm Street south of Broadway to the first alley;
- vi. Oak Street south of Broadway to Washington Avenue;
- vii. Superior Street south of Broadway to Washington Avenue;
- viii. Eddy Street to La Crosse Street;
- ix. the east-west alleys and the north-south alleys in Blocks 66, 67 and 68, Original Plat
- x. Broadway from Elm Street east to Cedar Street;
- xi. (Reserved for future Use)
- xii. Minnesota from Oak Street to Veterans Drive;
- xiii. Veterans Drive from Minnesota south to the driveway at south side of Post Office.

(3) Cost of Snow and Ice Removal.

(a) Determination of Costs. The costs of snow and/or ice removal from any street shall be determined on an "actual cost" basis (actual costs to be determined by the Public Works Committee prior to assessments.) Each property owner having snow and ice removed from the street adjacent to his property, whether by petition or otherwise, shall be assessed for the cost of such snow and ice removal from the frontage of his or her property on the city street in which the snow and ice is removed. Cost of snow and/or ice removal from street intersections shall be born by the City.

(b) Payment. Such cost of snow and/or ice removal shall be charged to the respective property owners and shall be paid on or before the first day of August of each year; if not paid it shall be assessed and levied against the property on the street or streets from which such snow and ice is removed in the same manner and with the same effect as other City taxes.
