Chairperson Mike Freel called the meeting to order at 6:00P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

1. Present: Ald. Mike Freel, Mayor Ed Wojnicz, Ald. Ben Anderson and Ald. Brian Holzem  
  
Others: Ald. Marshall, City Clerk/Coordinator Nancy R. Holzem, Police Chief Jody Ward, Public Works & Utilities Director David Holzem, City Planner/Zoning Administrator Chris Tollaksen, City Attorney Joseph Hasler, Monika Mielcarek, Damian Mielcarek, Qudratullah Khan, Belen Markovich from the *Dells Events*.
2. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Holzem to approve the June 11, 2018 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Holzem to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the application for renewal of **Taxicab Service License** received from Qudratullah Khan for the licensing period through March 31, 2019. Chief Ward stated that there have been no issues with this business. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Anderson to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the application for an **Original Class B Beer License** submitted by Monika Mielcarek for the Misiu Food Restaurant, 305 Broadway, for the licensing period of August 20, 2018 through June 20, 2019. The applicant confirmed that she has been a Wisconsin resident for at least 90 days as required by State Statute for an individual to hold a license. Motion carried unanimously.
5. Motion by Ald. Holzem seconded by Ald. Anderson to recommend to the Common Council for approval, a proposed ordinance to create code sec. 18.125.32 as part of code sec. 18.01(14) which adopts by reference the provisions of Wis. Statute 125.32 General Restrictions and Requirements Concerning Alcoholic Beverage Licenses and Premises; Including Possession of Beverages not Sold on Premises. Attorney Hasler stated that this Statute is currently not listed in our city code and that it needs to be added in order to be enforced. Motion carried unanimously.
6. No date was set for the next meeting.
7. Motion by Ald. Anderson seconded by Ald. Holzem to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:22pm.

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_  
(Creates Columbia County Ward 12)

The City of Wisconsin Dells, Columbia, Sauk, Adams and Juneau Counties, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to create Ward 12 in Columbia County due to an annexation. The property is contiguous with Ward 1 but is in a different Assembly District so a new ward has to be created.

SECTION II: PROVISIONS RENUMBERED AND CREATED

Wisconsin Dells Code sec. 2.02(12) is renumbered to 2.02(13)  
Wisconsin Dells Code sec. 2.02(12) is created.

SECTION III: PROVISIONS AS CREATED

Wisconsin Dells Code sec. 2.02(12) is created as follows:

2.02 WARDS AND COMMON COUNCIL DISTRICTS

*(12) Twelfth Ward. The Twelfth Ward shall consist of that part of the city located in Columbia County in Congressional District #6, Senate District 27 and Assembly District 81 and County Supervisory District 2. Beginning at the NE corner of Lot 2 of Certified Survey Map No. 5937; thence S29°21'47"W along the southeast line of said Lot 2, 292.58 feet to southeast corner of said Lot 2; thence S58°29'42"E, 29.65 feet; thence N61°53'10"E, 36.31 feet; thence N0°45'03"E, 187.47 feet; thence N47°16'43"W, 37.79 feet to point of beginning.  
(Half-acre lot in the back yard at 200 Windy Hill Road that was annexed from the Town of Newport.)*

- (12) (13) The Common Council Districts shall consist of the following wards:  
District One – Wards 1, 4, 7, 8, 10, 11 **and 12**  
District Two – Wards 2, 5 and 9.  
District Three – Wards 3 and 6.

SECTION IV: VALIDITY

Should any section, clause or provision of the ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION V: CONFLICTING PROVISIONS REPEALED

All ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its introduction and publication as provided by statute.



**18.03 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

- (1) Reference to State Statutes Adopted. See generally Code of Ordinances ss. 18.125.02 to 18.125.69.
- (2) Definitions. In this section the following terms shall have the following meanings:
  - (a) "Public Place" means any public street, highway, alley, sidewalk, parking lot, government building, park, or other public property.
- (3) Alcoholic Beverages in Public Places.
  - (a) Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages in Public Places. No person shall consume any intoxicating liquor, wine, or fermented malt beverage while in or upon any public place.
  - (b) Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages to be on Premises. No person who purchases wine, alcoholic or fermented malt beverages by the glass or in open containers shall consume the same other than upon the premises where served, and they shall not remove the same to public places in the City of Wisconsin Dells.
  - (c) Possession of Alcoholic Beverages in Public Places. No person shall be in possession of any glass or open container containing wine, alcoholic or fermented malt beverages in any public place.
  - (d) Permits Issued. Fraternal and service organizations and clubs may apply for a permit to have meetings, festivals, and activities held in a public place so that alcoholic and fermented malt beverages may be consumed during the time permitted as designated on the permit and within the area specified in the permit.
  - (e) Notices to be Posted. All premises licensed for the sale of fermented malt beverages, wine, or intoxicating liquor shall post a notice at each exit stating that "No beer, liquor, or wine may be carried in an open container out of this building."
- (4) Pedal Pubs. No person shall drink from or have in their possession an open container of fermented malt beverage or intoxicating liquor while on a commercial quadricycle as defined by s. 340.01(8m), Wis. Stat.; or while on any other type of commercial cycle.
