KIDZ KLUB

These programs are designed to provide educational, social, and recreational opportunities to the youth of Wisconsin Dells School District area. These programs are provided by the City of Wisconsin Dells and the Village of Lake Delton with the support of the Wisconsin Dells School District.

SUMMER DAY CAMP PROGRAM

This program is for kids to come out in the summer and participate in fun activities, arts and crafts, weekly themes, field trips, library programs, and more! Each week there is a new theme and we base our main activities off of those themes. Included with the program we also offer a lunch and a snack at no extra cost.


