

PARKING BOARD MEETING

APRIL 13, 2015

Chairperson Fox called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

Present: Chairman Ed Fox, Mayor Landers, Ald Ed Wojnicz, Ald. Mike Freel, Kelli Trumble, Keith Koehler, Police Chief Jody Ward and Public Works Director David Holzem .

Others: Ald. Dar Mor, Ald. Brian Holzem, Ald. Jesse Defosse, City Clerk Nancy Holzem, City Attorney Joe Hasler and Ed Legge representing the Wisconsin Dells Events.

1. Motion by Ald. Wojnicz and seconded by Keith Koehler to approve the minutes of the March 23, 2015 Parking Board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
2. Continued discussion and possible decision on safe-ride / over-night parking. Keith Koehler and taxi owner, Keisha Gregerson discussed the safe-ride program sponsored by the Tavern League. Chief Ward suggested the idea of donating some parking revenue towards the safe rider program. Koehler and Gregerson were asked to bring back some numbers. No action.
3. Continue discussion and any decision(s) on off-season parking ideas. Options were discussed again. Kelli Trumble specified important components to consider. These were: loss of revenue, perception of visitors, employee relations, and location of free parking. No action was taken.
4. Discussion/decision on Oak Street design and 200 Block of Broadway parking and the use of extended bump outs. This discussion was entirely about the new parking options for the 700 Block of Oak Street. A design of updated Oak Street was presented.

Motion made by Mayor Landers to approve the parking space design for Oak Street. All in favor except Freel who voted against.

5. Items for referral to subsequent meetings: Discuss overnight parking and off-season parking.
6. Motion by Ald. Freel and seconded by Mayor Landers to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
