

PARKING BOARD MEETING

May 11, 2015

Chairperson Fox called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

Present: Chairman Ed Fox, Kelli Trumble, Keith Koehler, Police Chief Jody Ward and Public Works Director David Holzem .

Others: Ald. Dar Mor, Keisha Gregerson and Ed Legge representing the Wisconsin Dells Events.

1. Motion by Keith Koehler and seconded by Kelli Trumble to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2015 Parking Board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Update on Oak Street project parking and any decisions, if applicable.

Director Holzem asked the parking board if there was support to remove a parking stall in front of Helland Law Office.

Motion by Trumble and seconded by Chief Ward to support the removal of the stall contingent upon legal counsel advice. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Continued discussion and possible decision on safe-ride / over-night parking.

Keith Koehler and taxi owner, Keisha Gregerson discussed the safe-ride program sponsored by the Tavern League. Lake Delton donated five thousand.

Motion by Chief Ward and seconded by Director Holzem to donate one thousand dollars. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Continue discussion and any decision(s) on off-season parking ideas.

Options were discussed again. Chief Ward agreed to bring off season parking statistics to the next meeting.

5. Discussion/decision on renting parking stalls.

Chief Ward discussed the renting of parking stalls and a request for street stalls in the 800 block of River Rd. Board unanimously agreed that street stalls were not to be rented. Jeremy Ringdahl discussed his future trolley plans. Chief Ward stated he was waiting to hear back from the City Attorney. No decision made on trolley spaces.

Motion by Koehler and seconded by Trumble to allow 3 stalls in the back row of lot #6 to be rented for \$350 each. Motion carried unanimously.

6. Items for referral to subsequent meetings: Discuss off-season parking.

8. Motion by Koehler and seconded by Director Holzem to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
