

**PARKING BOARD MEETING**

1. Motion by Ald. Wojnicz and seconded by Ald. Holzem to approve the minutes of the May 7, 2012 Parking Board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
2. Discussion on parking lots adjacent to the JAG. Several points were made regarding the parking areas including property that was barricaded off. Decided to leave the area as is for now.
3. Discussion on parking enforcement season dates. This was initially tabled until the other items on the agenda were discussed. Was later decided to table this topic completely until the summer parking revenue has been evaluated.
4. Discussion and review of the current parking kiosks.

Motion by Mayor Landers and seconded by Ald. Holzem to move the west kiosk in lot #1 to lot #8, add solar capabilities to it, if it can be accomplished by August 1. All in favor.

5. Discussion on future kiosk implementation. All seemed to be in favor of continuing to utilize the parking kiosks.

Motion by Mayor Landers and seconded by Ald. Holzem to direct the Chief of Police to bring a "Next Phase" plan to the next meeting. All in favor.

  - b) Discuss next phase of parking kiosk implementation
  - c) Discuss status of recently purchased properties by the parking board.  
i.e. Coach Light, Roekers and 600 Cedar lot.
