

**PARKING BOARD MEETING**  
CITY OF WISCONSIN DELLS

**AUGUST 11, 2014**

Chairperson Fox called the meeting to order at 6:05 P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

Present: Chairman Ed Fox, Mayor Landers, Ald. Ed Wojnicz, Ald. Mike Freel, Keith Koehler, Police Chief Jody Ward and Public Works Director David Holzem .

Others: City Clerk Nancy Holzem and Kay James representing the Wisconsin Dells Events.

1. Motion by Ald. Wojnicz and seconded by Keith Koehler to approve the minutes of the June 2, 2014 Parking Board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
2. Discussion and decision on request from Trinity Lutheran Church and School for "No Parking During School Days" signage in front of their buildings at 728 Church Street. Motion made by Ald. Freel and seconded by Ald. Fox to install the signs. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Discussion and possible decision on RV parking in the city limits. Ald. Freel stated that he observed RVs taking up multiple parking spots on city streets and wished to discuss RV Parking. Chief Ward stated that RVs could park for free in the lot behind city hall. Chief Ward will look into possible RV Parking sign locations and how to direct RVs to the City Hall Parking lot.
4. Continued discussion on ways to inform people of free off-season parking. Keith Koehler suggested putting stickers or altering the inside of parking meters to display free parking dates. Ald. Fox suggested that business advertise the free parking on their web-sites etc.
5. Preliminary discussion on 2015 operating and capital budgets. Chief Ward thought that the operating budget would be similar to 2014. Chief Ward presented some Capital Budget ideas including the removal of meters and curbs from Lot #2. Chief Ward will try to get some numbers together for the next Parking Board meeting.
6. Discussion on Committee Goals. Most of discussion from #4 applied.
7. Items for referral to subsequent meetings. Bob Steinweg asked to make some comments. He stated that the parking board should be careful about removing any public parking since it took many years to obtain these lots. Ald. Freel also commented about having a parking pay station at the boat launch. He was referred to the Rivers and Bays commission. Next Meeting August 27, 2014 at 6:00pm.
8. Motion by Ald. Freel and seconded by Keith Koehler to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
