

**LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING
CITY OF WISCONSIN DELLS
APRIL 10, 2017**

Chairperson Freel called the meeting to order at 6:45P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

1. Present: Ald. Mike Freel, Mayor Brian Landers, Ald. Ed Wojnicz, and Ald. Ed Fox

Others: Ald. Dar Mor, Ald. Brian Holzem, City Clerk/Coordinator Nancy Holzem, Police Chief Jody Ward, Public Works Director David Holzem, City Planner Chris Tollaksen, Eric Helland, Frank Fedie, Nihat Almas, Nancy Kimps, Adam Makowski, Ben Anderson, and Ed Legge from the *Dells Events*.
2. Motion by Ald. Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Fox to approve the March 13, 2017 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded Ald. Wojnicz to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the application for Original Class B Beer & Class C Wine Licenses submitted by Cheese Cake Heaven, Inc., Nancy Kimps agent, for Cheese Cake Heaven Restaurant, 231 Broadway, for the licensing period of April 19, 2017 thru June 30, 2017. Applicant requested the premises description on the application be amended to include their outdoor seating area against the building as well as the new café zone. Motion carried 3-1 with Ald. Fox voting no.
4. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded Ald. Wojnicz to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the application for an Original Class B Beer License submitted by MNEG Concessions LLC, Monte Mattei agent, for Gull Service Bar concession stand at 1881 Wisconsin Dells Parkway (Mt Olympus) for the licensing period of April 19, 2017 thru June 30, 2017. The other two locations indicated on their application, a dippin' dots stand and a shed in the parking lot, do not qualify for a beer license. None of the three proposed locations on their application form qualify for a Class C Wine License so that request was denied. Motion carried unanimously.
5. Motion by Ald. Wojnicz seconded by Mayor Landers to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the applications for renewal of Firework Sales Licenses received from Richard Christensen for 4 Travel Mart locations, Brian Holzem for 2 downtown retail locations, and from Mauer's Market, for the licensing period of May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.
6. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the application for renewal of Riding Stable/Horses for Hire License received from Dells Adventure Development for Beaver Springs Riding Stables for the licensing period of May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018. Chief Ward stated that there have been no issues with the horses. Motion carried unanimously.
7. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Wojnicz to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the request from Familyland Enterprises LLC to amend the premises

description on their Class B Beer & Class C Wine Licenses to include the outdoor café zone area. Ald. Fox stated that he does not like that beer and wine will be served in the café zones without anything to keep the alcohol from going down the street as the areas are not enclosed. Mayor Landers stated that these are established businesses and he does not feel there will be any problems with it. Police Chief Jody Ward agreed. Motion carried 3-1 with Ald. Fox voting no.

8. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Wojnicz to recommend to the Common Council for approval, the request by Travel Mart Inc, to amend the trade name (business name) on their Class B Beer & Class B (Quota Plus) Liquor License for 452 Broadway, from Taste of New Orleans to El Asador Mexican Restaurant. Motion carried unanimously.
9. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to recommend to the Common Council for approval, a proposed ordinance to create code sec. 10.30 which authorizes the Chief of Police to prohibit people from riding in cargo areas of motor vehicles during times of high traffic volume and activity associated with special events and festival. Motion carried unanimously.
10. Next meeting was scheduled for Monday, May 8th at 6:45pm, if needed.
11. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Fox to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:55pm.
