

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
CITY OF WISCONSIN DELLS
AUGUST 14, 2017

Chairperson Wojnicz called the meeting to order at 4:30P.M. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

2. Motion by Ald. Holzem seconded by Ald. Anderson to approve the June 5, 2017 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Wis. River Kayak & Tube Rental and American Zipline Consultants Conditional Use Permit Request for a Zipline at the Lower Dells (Mexicali Rose area).
The Public Safety Committee met at the same time as the City Plan Commission in order to review the information presented and hear the comments at the Public Hearing regarding a proposed zipline across the lower Dells bay area by Mexicali Rose. (Refer to City Plan Commission meeting minutes dated August 14, 2017 for a summary of the Public Hearing comments and follow up discussion.) Fire Chief Scott Walsh stated that he had no major concerns but added that if something were to happen and the river level is too high, he would not be sending the rescue boat out. The applicant stated that he was aware of that. Motion by Mayor Landers seconded by Ald. Anderson to give safety approval on the proposed river zipline project. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Next meeting date was set for Monday, September 11, 2017. Operating and capital budget for 2018 will be on the agenda.
